AYURVEDIC STRATEGIES FOR THE PREVENTION, MITIGATION AND REHABILITATION OF COVID-19 IN KERALA

1. The Ayurvedic Strategies for the Prevention, Mitigation and Rehabilitation of COVID-19 in Kerala will be initiated with the motto “*Karuthalode keralam, karuthekan Ayurvedam*” (കരുതലോടെ കേരളം കരുത്തേകാൻ ആയുർവേദം)
2. Ayurvedic COVID-19 response cells will be specifically constituted at the state, regional and district levels for the effective implementation of the Ayurvedic Strategies for the Prevention, Mitigation and Rehabilitation of COVID-19 in Kerala (The State Ayurveda COVID-19 Response Cell (SACRC), The Regional Ayurveda COVID-19 Response Cell (RACRC) and The District Ayurveda COVID-19 Response Cell (DACRC)).
3. The three Government Ayurveda Medical Colleges in Kerala will serve as the Regional Ayurveda COVID-19 Response Cells.
4. All Ayurvedic Dispensaries under the department of Indian Systems of Medicine and National AYUSH Mission across the state will serve as the basic implementation unit of the programme – *Ayur Raksha Clinics* for strengthening the preventive mechanisms against COVID-19 in the state
5. “*Swasthyam*” (സ്വാസ്ഥ്യം) – A comprehensive Ayurvedic programme for the preventive campaign against COVID-19 comprising of dietary, lifestyle and behavioural modifications with minimal specific medications for the entire population classified into seven groups on the basis of age and risk of COVID-19 exposure. The programme also envisages popularisation of simple and systematic exercises comprising of *Yoga* essentially for duration of 20 minutes daily for improving physical health, mental health and lung compliance.

6. “*Sukhayushyam*” (സുഖായുഷ്യം) – a special programme for the elderly above the age of 60 for the sustenance and promotion of general health, mental health and to minimise infection susceptibility as well as fatal complications
7. “*Punarjani*” (പുനർജനി) – The comprehensive Ayurvedic COVID-19 convalescent care programme. Specific Ayurvedic management for cured COVID-19 patients in the recovery phase after the mandatory isolation of 14 days after the discharge from hospital.
8. “*Niramaya*” (നിരാമയ) – the official virtual platform for enabling the effective utilisation of Ayurvedic strategies against COVID-19 in state.³
9. Formal discussions with public health machinery.
